When Jesus saw the people He felt sorry for them so He spent the rest of the day teaching them and healing the sick.

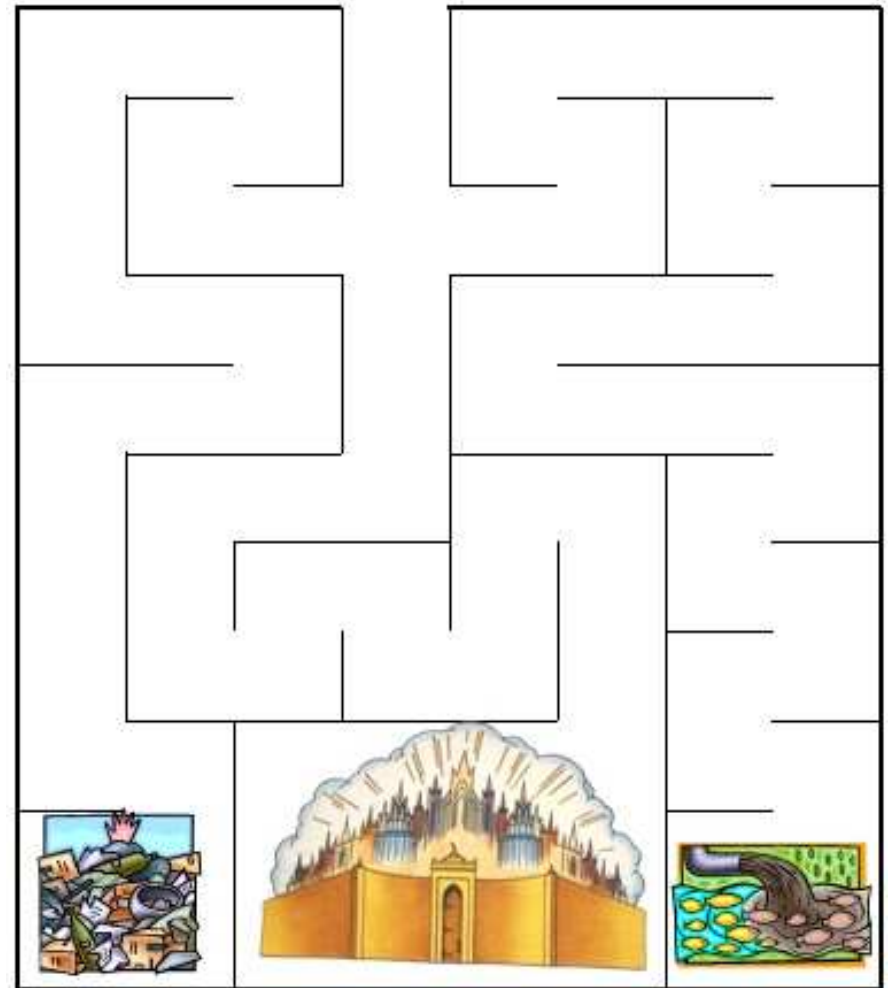


Then Jesus asked where they might get food for the people. Philip replied, "It would cost a fortune to feed all of these people!"



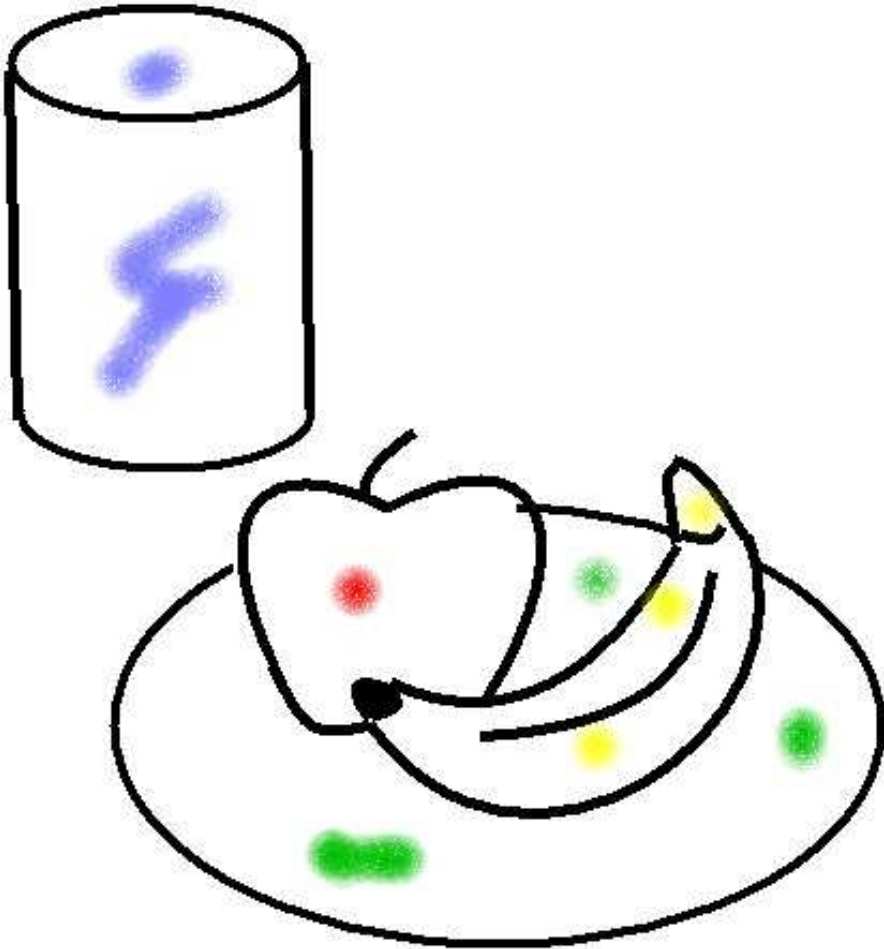
Andrew said "There's a boy here with five barley loaves and two fish for his lunch. But what good is that with all these people?"

same with the fish; and there was enough for everyone to eat as much as they wanted!

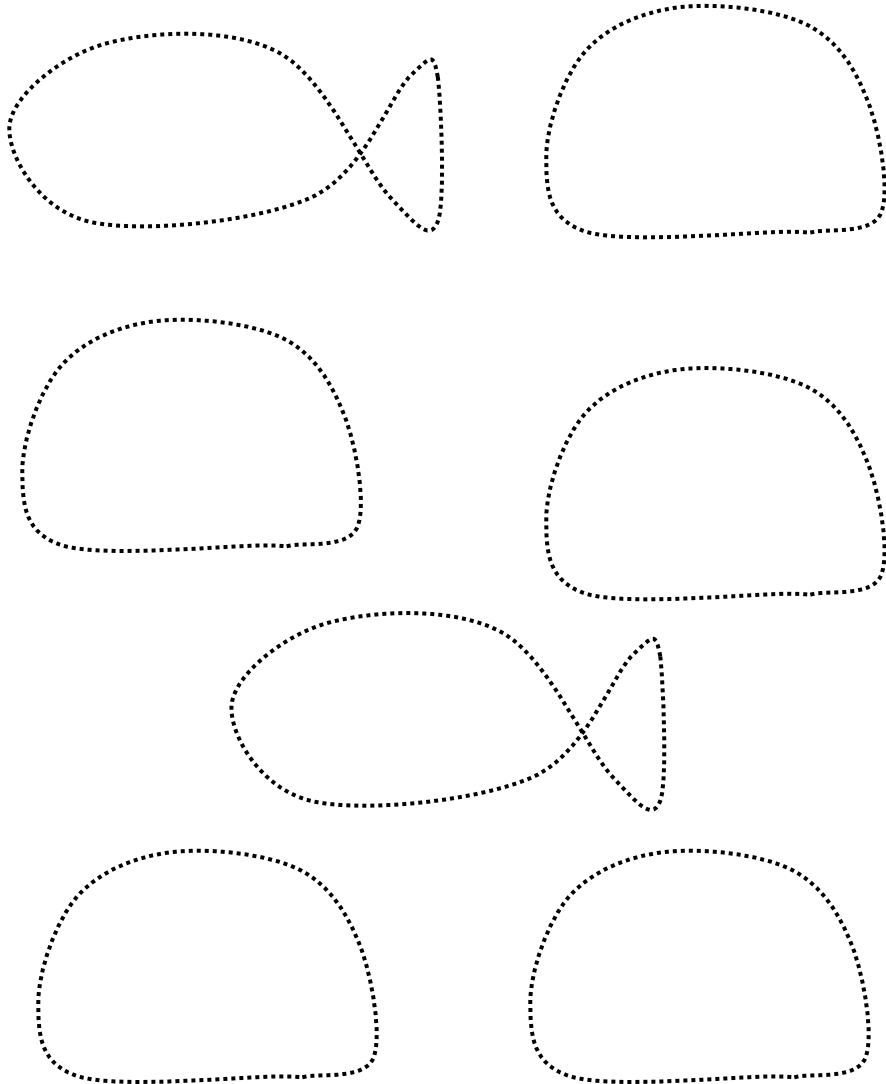
When everyone was finished, the disciples picked up the pieces and filled twelve baskets with leftovers!
